Overview

This document describes the suggested way to integrate the builder's website to the Homebuyer Homepage within the BuildTopia application.

Homebuyer Homepage

The Homebuyer Homepage functionality of the BuildTopia application allows buyer to access data about their house via the web from the Builder's webpage.

Activate the Homebuyer Homepage

1. Select the PS button for the project that the html code is to be created for
2. Click the Setup Tab.
3. Select the Setup link next to the Setup Homebuyer Homepage.
4. Select the contacts to be displayed on the homebuyer homepage.
5. Click the Save Info button.
6. Click the Checklist link.
7. Select any Checklist's to add to the Homebuyer homepage.
8. Click the Save info button.
9. Click the Permission link.
10. Select the schedule to display on the homepage.
11. Select whether to allow Service Requests from the Homebuyer Homepage
12. Select whether to allow the user to enter NSO's from the Homebuyer Homepage.
13. Click the Save Info button.

Builder Web Integration

1. Create a Homebuyer Homepage login page on your web site. See sample code in Exhibit 1.
2. The page needs to have a username and password and include your BuildTopia company Id and the project id where the house is located and directed to:
http://app1.buildtopia.com/english_exec/blogin OR
http://app2.buildtopia.com/english_exec/blogin

NOTE: If you do not open a new browser window, the user will need to lower their cookie settings to accept third party cookies.
